### Swimming

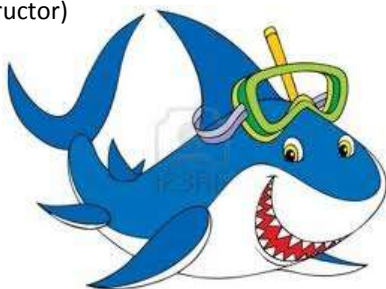

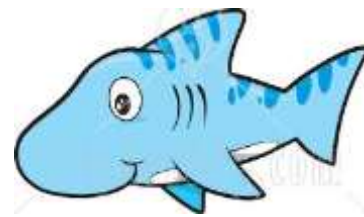
